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Subject: August 14, 2012 Florida Republican Primary election polling results of early voters for select races

Date: August 13, 2012

Executive Summary:

This poll of 4,676 early voters was conducted between Saturday, August 11, 2012 and Sunday, August 12, 2012. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of August 9th, 2012. The sample of voters that were called included a proportional sample of all registered Republican voters in the state of Florida.

The only statewide race included was the Republican primary for the U.S. Senate, the other Republican races surveyed were for the Florida state Senate and Legislature, and Pinellas County Sheriff.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system, with each voter being polled only on the races that are within their precinct and political party. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the full voter population for each race. The demographics used were: race, gender and age.

In order to qualify respondents as early voters, only those voters that had requested mail ballots or had participated in early voting were called. Also, voter households that had voters of different political parties were excluded from the survey.

The scientific results shown in the summary below should be within at most a 4-6% margin of error and a 95% confidence level.
