Subject: 2012 Pinellas County Florida General Election polling results of early voters and likely voters for select races

Date: November 2, 2012

Executive Summary:

This poll of early voters and likely voters was conducted on Thursday, November 1, 2012. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of October 3rd, 2012. The sample of voters that were called included a random samples of registered voters in Pinellas County Florida as a whole as well as within Florida House districts 65 and 68.

The races surveyed included: Pinellas County Sheriff, County Commission and Florida House districts 65 and 68.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the early voter population and the registered voter population separately. The demographics used were: political party, race and age.

The voters polled were chosen at random within Pinellas County Florida and within the districts of each polled race.

This poll is different from our recent polls in that we have in effect conducted two separate polls for each race: a poll of registered voters that uses a sample from only early voters who have turned in their ballots and then weights the results against the demographics of only early voters, and a second poll of registered voters that uses a sample from only those people who have not yet voted in the upcoming election and then weights the results against the demographics of all registered voters who have not yet voted. "Early voters" consist of voters that voted by mail or in person through October 31st.

In order to qualify respondents as early voters, the early voters were asked if they had already turned in their ballot for the November 6th general election. In order to qualify other respondents as likely voters, they were asked if they were planning to vote in the November 6th general election. Only if each group responded yes were they then asked the other questions in this poll.

Summary of Scientific Results:

The scientific results shown in the summary below will have the sample size and margin of error for each set of results shown above those results. The margins of error shown are all at a 95% confidence level.
