

Subject: Florida State House District 63 Election survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com

Date: October 28, 2014

Executive Summary:

This poll of Florida 413 active voters was conducted on Tuesday, October 28, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of September 4, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Florida State House District 63.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2014 election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Florida State House District 63. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within Florida State House District 63. Only those voters that said they were planning to vote were included in the results. Only those voters that voted in the 2010 or 2012 general elections were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 413 and a 4.8% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.

Summary of Scientific Results:

If the election for Governor of Florida were held today, who would you vote for: Republican Rick Scott, Democrat Charlie Crist or Libertarian Adrian Wyllie?

Scott:	49.5%

In the race for the Florida House district 63 who would you vote for: Republican Shawn Harrison or Democrat Mark Danish?
