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Subject: Florida State Senate District 16 Republican Election survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com

Date: July 10, 2014

Executive Summary:

This poll of 429 Florida registered Republican Primary voters was conducted on Thursday, July 10, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 6, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of registered Republican Primary voters within the boundaries of Florida State Senate District 16.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2014 election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the registered Republican Primary voter population for Florida State Senate District 16. The demographics used were: race, age and gender.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the registered Republican Primary voter population within Florida State Senate District 16. Only those voters that said they were planning to vote and that had voted in a recent primary election were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 429 and a 4.7% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
