Subject: Florida State House, Pinellas County General Election survey conducted for SaintPetersBlog.com

Executive Summary:

This poll of 1394 Pinellas County Florida likely voters was conducted on Wednesday June 4, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of March 19, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Pinellas County Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the November 2014 general election, including Florida State House races.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the registered voter population within each Florida State House district. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the registered voter population within Pinellas County Florida. Only respondents that stated that they were planning to vote in the November general election were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have their sample size and Margin of Error shown next to the results.
