Subject: Pinellas County Commission District 4 Primary Election survey conducted for SaintPetersBlog.com

Date: February 3, 2014

Executive Summary:

This poll of 314 Pinellas County District 4 registered Republican voters was conducted on Monday February 3, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of January 3rd, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of registered Republican voters within the boundaries of the 4th County Commission District of Pinellas County Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2014 County election primary.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active(2010 and 2012) Republican voter population for Pinellas County's District 4. The demographics used were: race, age and gender.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the registered Republican voter population within Pinellas County's District 4.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 314 respondents and a Margin of Error of 5.5% at a 95% confidence level.
