**Date: January 20, 2014**

**Executive Summary:**

This unscientific poll of 624 City of Tampa, Florida registered voters was conducted on Monday, January 20, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of January 3, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the city of Tampa, Florida.

The issues surveyed included hypothetical contests for Mayor and several city issues.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results of this poll are not scientific and were not weighted.
