Subject: Florida U.S. Congressional District 13 Special Election survey conducted for SaintPetersBlog.com

Date: February 12, 2014

Executive Summary:

This poll of 1130 Florida U.S. Congressional District 13 active voters was conducted on Wednesday February 12, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of January 3rd, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of active registered voters within the boundaries of the 13th U.S. Congressional District of Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the March 2014 special election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active(2010 and 2012) voter population for Florida's U.S. Congressional District 13. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the registered voter population within Florida's U.S. Congressional District 13. Only voters that stated they were planning to vote in the March special election were included in this survey.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 1130 respondents and a Margin of Error of 2.9% at a 95% confidence level.

Summary of Scientific Results:

If the special election for the US Congressional district 13 seat were held today, would you vote for Republican David Jolly, Democrat Alex Sink or Libertarian Lucas Overby?
