**Date: May 8, 2014**

**Executive Summary:**

This poll of 795 Florida U.S. Congressional District 13 registered voters was conducted on Thursday, May 8, 2014. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of March 19th, 2014. The sample of voters that were called included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the 13<sup>th</sup> U.S. Congressional District of Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2014 general election.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the registered voter population for Florida's U.S. Congressional District 13. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the registered voter population within Florida's U.S. Congressional District 13. Only voters that stated they were planning to vote in the November general election were included in this survey.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 795 respondents and a Margin of Error of 3.5% at a 95% confidence level.
