Executive Summary:

This poll of 336 Florida likely Democratic primary voters was conducted on August 23rd, 2016. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of July 12, 2016. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Florida's 9th Congressional District.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2016 primary election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active Democratic primary voter population for Florida's 9th Congressional District. The demographics used were: race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within Florida's 9th Congressional District. Only voters that stated they had already voted or were planning to vote were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 336 and a 5.3% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
