Subject: Pinellas County Congressional Election Survey conducted for Florida Politics.com

Date: November 6, 2016

Executive Summary:

This poll of 944 Florida likely voters was conducted on November 6th, 2016. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of October 20, 2016. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Florida's 13th Congressional District.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2016 general election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Florida's 13th Congressional District. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within Florida's 13th Congressional District. Only voters that responded that they had voted or were planning to vote were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 944 and a 3.2% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level. The "EARLY" results shown below are the respondents who stated that they had already voted. The "LIKELY" results shown below are the respondents who stated that they planned to vote.
