Subject: U.S. Congressional District 5 survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com

Date: April 25, 2016

Executive Summary:

This poll of 524 Florida likely Democratic primary voters was conducted on April 25, 2016. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of April 5, 2016. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Florida's 5th Congressional district.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2016 primary election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active Democratic primary voter population for Florida's 5th Congressional district. The demographics used were: race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within Florida's 5th Congressional district. Only those voters that voted in a primary election in 2012 or 2014 were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the first question below has a sample size of 524 and a 4.3% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
