Florida Statewide General Election survey conducted by ShadowVote and Analyzed by StPetePolls.org

Date: November 7, 2016

Executive Summary:

This poll of 2,319 Florida likely voters was conducted from November 1 to November 6, 2016. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of October 20, 2016. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the state of Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to Florida's General Election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through an automated email web-survey system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for the state of Florida. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The voters polled were chosen at random within the registered voter population within the state of Florida.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 2,319 and a 2.0% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
