Executive Summary:

This poll of 421 Tampa, Florida likely voters was conducted from December 2nd to December 3rd, 2016. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of October 20, 2016. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Tampa Florida's 7th City Council District.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2016 Tampa special election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Tampa Florida's 7th City Council District. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within Tampa Florida's 7th City Council District. Those voters who responded that they were not voting in the special election were excluded from the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 421 and a 4.8% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
