### **Executive Summary:**

This poll of 754 St. Petersburg, Florida registered voters was conducted on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the City of St. Petersburg.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2017 City of St. Petersburg primary and general elections.

### **Methodology:**

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for City of St. Petersburg. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within City of St. Petersburg.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 754 and a 3.6% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level

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
