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**Subject: City of St. Petersburg Election Survey
conducted for StPetePolls.org**

Date: October 2, 2017

Executive Summary:

This poll of 1,012 St. Petersburg, Florida registered voters was conducted on October 2nd, 2017. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of July 11th, 2017. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the City of St. Petersburg.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2017 City of St. Petersburg general election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the estimated 2017 active primary voter population for the City of St. Petersburg. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within the City of St. Petersburg.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 1,012 and a 3.1% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.

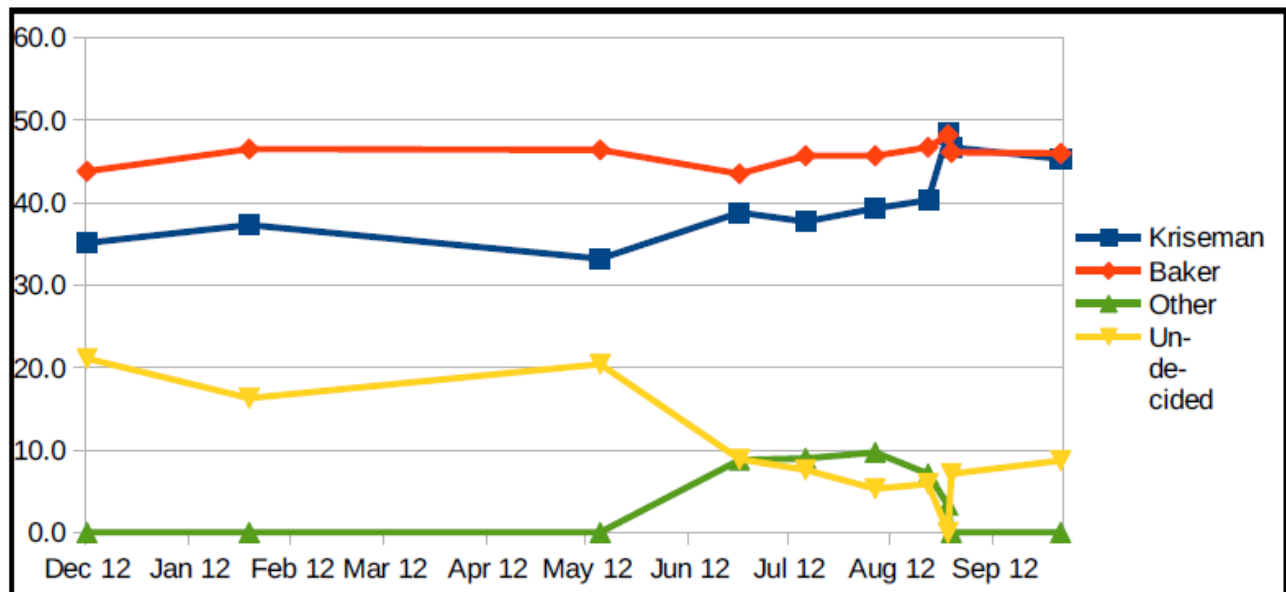
