**Subject: Florida State House District 72 Special Election Survey  
conducted for FloridaPolitics.com**

**Date: February 11, 2018**

**Executive Summary:**

This poll of 702 Florida likely voters was conducted from February 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the 72<sup>nd</sup> Florida State House district.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2018 special election.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for the 72<sup>nd</sup> Florida State House district. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within the 72<sup>nd</sup> Florida State House district. Only those voters who stated that they were planning to vote or had already voted in the special election were included in the results below.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 702 and a 3.7% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
