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Subject: City of St Petersburg Survey conducted for StPetePolls.org

Date: July 19, 2019

Executive Summary:

This poll of 208 St Petersburg, Florida registered voters was conducted from July 17th to July 19th, 2019. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of April 2nd, 2019. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the 3rd City Council district of the City of St Petersburg, Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the City of St Petersburg 2019 primary election.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted by an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for the 3rd City Council district of the City of St Petersburg. The demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

The sample of voters polled was chosen at random within the registered voter population within the 3rd City Council district of the City of St Petersburg.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 208 and a 6.8% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
