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**Subject: Duval County Florida survey conducted for
FloridaPolitics.com**

Date: August 9, 2020

Executive Summary:

This poll of 608 likely Duval County Republican primary voters was conducted from August 8-9, 2020. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 9th, 2020. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered Republican party voters within the boundaries of Duval County, Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the Republican Primary election in Duval County, Florida.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active Republican primary voter population for Duval County, Florida. The weighting demographics used were: race, age and gender.

Only voters who stated that they were voting in the primary election were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 608 and a 4.0% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
