### **Executive Summary:**

This poll of 1,232 likely Hillsborough County primary voters was conducted on August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Hillsborough County, Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to Primary election in Hillsborough County, Florida.

### Methodology:

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active primary voter population for Hillsborough County, Florida. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

Only voters who stated that they were voting in the primary election were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 1,232 and a 2.8% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
