**Subject: Hillsborough County Florida School Board District 5 survey  
conducted for FloridaPolitics.com**

**Date: October 7, 2020**

**Executive Summary:**

This poll of 446 likely Hillsborough County, Florida School Board district 5 voters was conducted on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Hillsborough County, Florida's School Board district 5.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the General election in Hillsborough County, Florida.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Hillsborough County, Florida's School Board district 5. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

Only voters who stated that they were planning to vote in the November general election were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 446 and a 4.6% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
