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Subject: Pinellas County Florida survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com

Date: April 27, 2020

Executive Summary:

This poll of 3,697 registered Pinellas County voters was conducted on April 27th, 2020. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of February 11th, 2020. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Pinellas County, Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the COVID-19 restrictions in Pinellas County, Florida.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Pinellas County, Florida. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age, gender and media market.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 3,697 and a 1.6% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
