Executive Summary:

This poll of 522 likely Florida State Senate District 9 voters was conducted from October 31 to November 1, 2020. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of October 13th, 2020. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Florida's 9th State Senate District.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the general election in Florida's 9th State Senate District.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Florida's 9th State Senate District. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

Only voters who had stated that they were likely to vote in the November 2020 general election were included in the results.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 522 and a 4.3% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.

Florida's State Senate District 9 Voters' Demographics

Here are the demographics for all registered voters, the active voters and the difference between the two. For this poll, we weighted based upon the demographics of the active voters. An "active" voter is considered active if they have voted in an election in the last 4 years. All percentages are rounded.
