**Subject: Tampa, Florida survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com**

**Date: March 1, 2023**

**Executive Summary:**

This poll of 345 Tampa, Florida likely voters was conducted February 28 to March 1, 2023. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of January 17, 2023. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Tampa, Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the City Council election in Tampa, Florida.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted through a combination of an automated phone call polling system and a manual P2P SMS polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Tampa, Florida. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

Voters who said they were not planning on voting in the March Tampa election were excluded from the results.

The share of respondents by contact method: Phone call = 86% SMS texting = 14%

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 345 and a 5.3% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.

\*Question 4 has a sample size of 141 and a 8.3% Margin of Error.

\*Question 5 has a sample size of 109 and a 9.4% Margin of Error.
