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**Subject: Florida U.S. Congressional District 14 survey conducted for
FloridaPolitics.com**

Date: July 15, 2026

Executive Summary:

This poll of 469 Florida U.S. Congressional District 14 likely voters was conducted on July 14-15, 2026. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 9, 2026. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Florida U.S. Congressional District 14 as adopted in May of 2026.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2026 general and primary elections for Florida U.S. Congressional District 14.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through a combination of an automated phone call polling system and a manual P2P SMS polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for Florida U.S. Congressional District 14. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

Respondents that stated they were not voting in the election were excluded from the results.

The share of respondents by contact method: Phone call = 37% SMS texting = 63%

The scientific results shown for the General Election questions below have a sample size of 469 and a 4.5% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.

The scientific results shown for the Republican Primary Election questions below have a separate sample size of 376 and a 5.1% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
