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**Subject: Florida U.S. Congressional District 24 Democratic Primary survey
conducted for FloridaPolitics.com**

Date: July 17, 2026

Executive Summary:

This poll of 303 Florida U.S. Congressional District 24 likely Democratic Primary voters was conducted on July 16-17, 2026. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 9, 2026. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered Democratic voters within the boundaries of Florida U.S. Congressional District 24 as adopted in May of 2026.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2026 primary election for Florida U.S. Congressional District 24.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through a combination of an automated phone call polling system and a manual P2P SMS polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active Democratic primary voter population for Florida U.S. Congressional District 24. The weighting demographics used were: race, age and gender.

Respondents that stated they were not voting in the election were excluded from the results.

The share of respondents by contact method: Phone call = 62% SMS texting = 38%

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 303 and a 5.6% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
