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Subject: Jacksonville, Florida survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com

Date: August 20, 2026

Executive Summary:

This poll of 618 Jacksonville, Florida likely voters was conducted on August 19-20, 2026. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of July 14, 2026. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of Jacksonville, Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to the 2027 election for Mayor of Jacksonville, Florida.

Methodology:

The poll was conducted through a combination of an automated phone call polling system and a manual P2P SMS polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active primary voter population for Jacksonville, Florida. The weighting demographics used were: political party, race, age and gender.

Respondents that stated they were not voting in the election were excluded from the results.

The share of respondents by contact method: Phone call = 56% SMS texting = 44%

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 618 and a 3.9% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
